That would be fine with me. The trips start March 18 and they do trips weekly, it looks like. The first 2 trips in April are the "Waterpocket Fold", which looks great (www.ecohike.com/fold.htm). If we sign up before the end of the year, we get a discount (2006 prices instead of 2007 prices). Waterpocket Fold is the longest and most expensive trip - 6 days, \$1375 (2006) \$1445 (2007). I prefer a trip without "exposure" which I think means that you will be on trails where if you make a misstep you could fall to your death. They don't use "exposure" in the description of this trip, but:

"This trip is rated from moderate to challenging. It will include one day when we move camp. The hike into our first camp is 5 miles. This day is a challenging way to start the trip; it includes an 800' descent with a steep pitch. The hike out of our second and last camp is six miles."
