Dear Tom,

I called Steve at the west Saginaw Dominoes last week. He says that I picked up your check. I'm not sure I did, but if I did, I mailed it to you. I mailed you one check, but I don't remember if it was the Dominoes check or the State Journal check. Steve said the check was for June 18-July 1, and it was for \$105.40. If you would like to call their payroll office to see if the check has been paid, their phone number is (404) 840-2334. If the check hasn't been paid, you may be able to get them to re-issue it.

You said that after I made the \$700 payment on your loan, you had a hard time convincing them that you didn't owe them anything for a while. My intent in making a large, lump-sum payment is not to relieve you from having to make payments. I suspect that a large percent of your monthly payment goes for interest on the loan, and if you continue paying the minimum payment, you won't reduce the principle very fast. My intent in making a large payment is to make a big cut in the principle so that less of your payment is wasted on interest. So send me the name and address of the loan servicing agent (or agents). I'd also like to know how much you owe and who you owe it to.
